*An elegant champagne with appley well integrated style. Fresh and crisp* Rose £55.00  
*with a lightly full-bodied character.* By The Glass £9.50
- 2 *Ruinart. Blanc De Blanc. Brut.* £95.00  
*Finely enhanced aroma, supple elegant flavour with a taut mousse.*
- 3 *Krug Grande Cuvee.* £175.00  
*Now showing immense potential. Smoky, lemony character,*  
*a touch of brioche, mineral white fruits and honey. Magisterial.*

Sparkling Wine

- 4 *Cremant d'Alsace. Michel Leon. Brut.* £29.50  
*Elegant French fizz. Complex bouquet of white flowers and fruit.*  
*Delicate fine bubbles balanced with fresh citrus notes. Alsace's answer to champagne.*
- 5 *Pelorus. Cloudy Bay. Marlborough. Brut.* £40.00  
*Superb New Zealand sparkler with elegant fizz and full ripe flavour.*

- 6 *Nero d'Avola. Artemesia. Sicily. Red Wine.* £17.50  
*Medium-bodied, fruity, spicy red with a gamey earthiness & good length.*
- 7 *Huntersville. Pinotage. South Africa.* £17.50  
*Superb young pinotage, plum and fruitcake flavours and subtle oak. Juicy and smooth.*
- 8 *Pinot Grigio. Soprano. Italy.* £17.50  
*Fresh, crisp and fruity on the nose with floral notes. The palate is crisp and dry*  
*with refreshing acidity.*
- 8a *Pinot Grigio Rosato, Laroma, Araldica, Pavia, Italy.* £17.50  
*Fresh and delicate Pinot Grigio blush with rose scented charm.*
- 9 *Saint Marc. Foncalieu. Chardonnay. White Wine.* £17.50  
*Superb French Chardonnay, smooth with a neat dry finish.*
- 10 *Reh Kendermann, Riesling Spatlese. White Wine* £17.50  
*Mosel wine made with Riesling grapes producing a semisweet wine*  
*bursting with fruit with a typical floral nose.*

### French White

- 11 *Montagny. Louis Latour.* £29.75  
*Appetising white burgundy mixing smooth butter with lemon tones.*
- 12 *Chablis. Saint Martin. Domaine Laroche.* £34.75  
*Dry, crisp, green & expressive with a delicate honeyed aftertaste. Fine example.*
- 13 *Sancerre. Domaine Vacheron.* £39.75  
*Highly praised Sancerre producer living up to the Domaine reputation.  
Racy top notes of greengages and fresh cut grass meet on a mineral edge.*
- 14 *Viognier. Laurent Miguel.* £24.75  
*Skilful wine making keeps the true peach note right through to a long cool finish.*

### French Red

- 15 *Corbieres. Calmel & Joseph.* £25.50  
*Deep garnet in colour with violet reflections. Powerful scent of preserved fruit  
with hints of liquorice, fennel and thyme. Great originality.*
- 16 *Côtes du Rhône, Auguste Bessac.* £22.50  
*This young Rhone wine is well ripened, fresh & fruity with a spicy nose.*
- 17 *Chateau Pierrail. Bordeaux Superieur.* £29.75  
*Carries a forest signature of wild berries and sweetly charred timber.  
Very rewarding.*
- 18 *Vosne-Romanee. Vincent Ravaut.* £75.00  
*First class Burgundy living up to the reputation of this famous location.  
Supple, wrap around flavours that are mouth filling and have a touch of the exotic.*

### Alsace Wine

- 19 *Turckheim. Cave Tradition Pinot Gris.* £25.50  
*Very aromatic, rich and full. This is a classy Pinot Gris in the Alsace style.*

### Italian Wine

- 20 *Amarone Della Valpolicella. Zonin.* £65.00  
*Ripe, warm and generous on the nose with aromas of hedgerow berries. Full bodied and richly flavoured with sundried fruit, balanced tannins and a spicy dry bite of a good Amarone.*
- 21 *Passitivo. Primitivo. Puglia.* £23.75  
*The grapes for this wine are air-dried and the result is a rich and deeply textured wine with flavours of prunes, raisins and chocolate notes.*
- 22 *Frascati Superiore. Zonin.* £19.50  
*Rome's beloved white is appreciated for its unemphatic character. Youthful freshness and mouth-filling flavour.*

### Spanish Wine

- 23 *Pies Negros. Artuke. Rioja.* £28.50  
*Very exclusive and from a boutique winery that is really making waves on the Spanish wine scene - the grapes are still trodden by foot, hence the name (Black Feet). A modern, fruit driven style of Rioja, aged at the winery for over 1 year before release with dark fruits, herbal notes and refreshing minerality.*
- 24 *Marques De Murrieta Reserva. Rioja.* £42.50  
*One of the grandest Riojas. Black/Red colour, a dark, rich, spicy, dense wine. Full of flavour.*
- 25 *Tremendus. Rioja Blanco.* £20.50  
*Unfortunately named but very refreshing and zesty interpretation of Rioja's principal white grape with delicate floral notes and a good citrus character.*
- 26 *La Suerta de Arrayan. Garnacha. Mentrída.* £29.50  
*Deep cherry colour. Powerful aroma, rich in dark fruit and spices. Robust, very well balanced with velvety tannins. Acclaimed as Spain's best Garnacha.*

### Portuguese Wine.

- 27 *Touriga Nacional. Point West. Lisboa.* £29.50  
*High quality, intense colour, forest fruit flavours and subtle oak. Deliciously smooth but with real concentration of flavours.*
- 28 *Grande'Arte. Alvarinho. Lisboa.* £27.00  
*Real finesse with an intense aroma of ripe orchard fruits. Delicious creamy tropical character and yet a fresh, citrus quality. Superb, complex and full bodied.*

### Chilean Wine

- 29 *Casa Azul. Pinot Noir. Casablanca Valley. A lovely and elegant wine from Chile. Red strawberry fruits dominate but with subtle hints of black fruits and a touch of game. An excellent expression of cooler climate Pinot Noir.* £24.50
- 30 *Santa Alba. Sauvignon Blanc. Curico Valley. A blend of herbal notes with gooseberries and ripe melon combine with zingy citrus flavours to give a crisp refreshing sauvignon.* £21.50
- 31 *Urmeneta Rosé. Cabernet-Merlot. Central Valley. Attractively off-dry in an easy going style. Fruity, clean and well balanced.* £23.50
- 32 *Urmeneta. Merlot. Central Valley. Ripe plummy fruit with herbaceous and spicy notes. Great weight and mouthfeel with soft, well rounded tannins.* £23.50

### Californian Wine

- 33 *Hahn Winery. Cabernet Sauvignon. Aromas of red cherry and currant jam complimented by notes of vanilla and caramel. Berry flavours and chewy tannins on the long smooth finish.* £32.50

### Argentinean Wine

- 34 *Mendoza. Bodegas Terrazas. Malbec Reserva. This wine is a fine example of what Argentina is able to produce at its best. This malbec reserva is a real hero with its dark succulent fruit enlivened with tropical dash and a soft green herb twist. Ready to drink.* £39.50
- 35 *Lujan de Cuyo. Viñalba Selección Torrontés. Argentina's signature white grape demonstrates lovely floral notes of rose and jasmine. Very fruity with fresh grapefruit and pineapple flavours. An excellent food wine.* £24.50

### Australian Wine

- 36 *Rocky Road. McHenry Hohnen. Margaret River. Shiraz. Perhaps the perfect sleek and glossy shiraz. Smooth with richly spiced flavours, mouth filling and runs on forever.* £36.50
- 37 *Brightview. Simon Hackett. Barossa. Chardonnay. Beautiful Barossa Chardonnay offers a dazzling fruit cocktail in a finely integrated wine.* £34.50

### Lebanese Wine

- 38 *Chateau Musar* £42.75  
*Brick red in colour, with lots of ripe fruit, tempered by an underlying earthiness and high acidity from the 20% cinsault in the blend.  
This wine finishes strongly with a medley of unique flavours.*

### New Zealand Wine

- 39 *Dog Point. Sauvignon Blanc. Marlborough.* £36.50  
*This is first class New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc.  
Zingy gooseberry notes and an elegance missing from many of its contemporaries.*
- 40 *Spy Valley. Sauvignon Blanc. Marlborough.* £28.50  
*Luscious, ripe, creamy vanilla nose over classic gooseberry fruit with hints of green pepper. Brilliantly crisp, a ripe intensity of fruit and huge citrus flavours.*
- 41 *The Crossings. Pinot Noir. Milestone Series. Marlborough.* £34.50  
*Fine aromas of red cherry, spice, raspberry and gentle smokiness.  
Vibrantly intense, full, rich and silky.*

### South African Wine

- 42 *Signal Canon. Chenin Blanc.* £24.75  
*A complex nose of stewed pears, ripe melon and apples with a hint of jasmine.  
The wine has a well structured palate with supreme balance and a long finish.*
- 43 *Painted Wolf. Pinotage.* £29.75  
*A great South African Pinotage. Aromas of dried fruits, cherries and spice.  
The palate is deliciously rich with plum, black cherry, toasty cedar and a spicy edge.*
- 44 *Gold Coast. Shiraz-Cinsault. Western Cape.* £21.50  
*Smoky, spicy and brambly with clear hints of clove and cinnamon.  
Dark fruits with peppery overtones along with silky smooth tanins.*
- 45 *Topiary. Shiraz. South Africa.* £42.50  
*Great example of shiraz, a full red with dark fruit flavours, hints of nutmeg and clove.  
Lightly wooded with a lingering silky finish.*
- 46 *Baldrick. Vondeling. Paarl. Shiraz, Mourvedre , Viognier.* £27.50  
*Rich, deep purple colour, opulent red fruit with a hint of caramel and a perfumed aroma of fruit and floral notes. Shiraz is the heart providing palate volume, dark fruit and pepper spices. Superb!*
